### M.S. (Animal Science)

#### Philosophy

To develop the knowledge and to integrate research, create innovation and produce the young researchers

#### Program plan

- Plan A1: This plan is focused on only thesis for 36 credits, and 7 non-credits of assigned subjects.
- Plan A2: This plan required courseworks and thesis no less than 36 credits: 12 credits of thesis, 9 credits of major courses, 15 credits of elective courses; and 7 non-credits of assigned subjects.

#### Qualifications

The perspective students should

- hold a bachelor's degree in agriculture majoring in animal science, animal husbandry, dairy and beef cattle, swine production, animal feed or equivalent in related field or.
- hold a bachelor's degree in agricultural Science or other related fields. The perspective students may have to study other basic courses according to recommendation of the advisor committee and/or curriculum committee.

#### Educational system

The system is divided into two semesters per academic year. Each semester at least 15 weeks.

#### **Graduation Requirement**

- 1. Pass the required subjects;
- 2. Pass the English test;
- 3. Pass the comprehensive examination;
- 4. Pass the thesis defensive test;
- 5. Thesis publication
  - Two peer-review articles for plan A1
  - One Peer-review articles for plan A2

#### Tuition fee

Approximately 60,000 Bahts for the whole program (excluding summer semester) For international students, there is an international fee will be paid for 20,000 Bahts/semester. (30 Baths : 1 USD)
